### **a. Main changes academic standards and procedures 2026-2027**

#### **Article 2.4.1d: Breadth requirement**

This article has been revised to align with other degree requirements in the AS&P, which mention EC instead of the number of courses. The choice to prescribe EC stems from the fact that AUC students also take off-campus / study abroad courses that are worth less or more than our 6 EC courses. To avoid confusion and problems related to graduation, this article now stipulates that students must obtain 12 EC in each major other than their own, regardless of the number of courses taken.

#### **Article 2.6.1: Major requirements**

The formulation of this article has been slightly revised to clarify that research methods courses (first bullet point) do not count towards the 66 EC that students must complete within their major (second bullet point).

#### **Article 2.10.4: Off-campus courses**

The wording of this article has been sharpened to clarify that students must submit their off-campus request to the Board of Examiners (BoE) six weeks before the start of the course. The BoE has the discretion to deviate from the rule in case of force majeure or exceptional personal circumstances.

#### **Article 2.12.2: Community Projects and Internships (CPI)**

This article has been added to prohibit the combination of a CPI project with any other course in the January and June 4-week periods. The motivation for this change is provided [here](#).

#### **Article 3.2.4: Assessment in courses**

This article has been adapted to clarify that course manuals must be made available to students before the start of the course. Furthermore, the article now explicates that changes to a course assessment structure cannot be made without prior approval from the Board of Examiners. This applies to changes after the course manual has been published / provided to students, whilst the course is running. Such changes include, for example, adjustments to assessment format or weight.

#### **Article 3.8.1: Academic awards**

This article has been revised to clarify that all courses that count towards AUC's degree programme will be used to calculate a student's GPA. Courses taken by students outside the degree requirements, for example when a student completes off-campus courses beyond the permitted maximum of 42 EC, will not be included in the GPA calculation. Such courses will emerge on the diploma supplement under a separate heading, with their own GPA.

The article now also states that students who fail to comply with article 2.10.4, and who do not submit an off-campus course request to the Board of Examiners six weeks before the start of the course, will not see such courses included on their diploma supplement or

included in their GPA. The Board of Examiners has the discretion to deviate from art. 2.10.4 in case of exceptional circumstances or force majeure.

**b. List of courses that cannot both count toward the degree requirements**

The list below indicates courses that have considerable overlap with courses that are also offered or have previously been offered at AUC. Students are not allowed to count both these courses toward the degree requirements.

This list is applicable to students who started their AUC studies in or after September 2023. Students who started before September 2023 must also abide by the list of courses in the transition document 2025-2026, which can be found on the student website [here](#).
