

Combined method - evaluate by code in class, followed by email after teaching period.

Student login (UvAnetID) is required for all options explained below under 'Live in the classroom'.

'Live in the classroom' phase

Option 1: When the teacher decides that students need to scan a QR code in the classroom, the students take out their mobile phones to scan the code. After scanning, they must log in with their UvA student ID, unless they already logged into the browser via SURF earlier that day. Once logged in, the student can view the evaluation. Below is a chronological overview of what a student sees after scanning a QR code.

Option 2: The teacher can also choose for students to fill out the evaluation on their laptop during the live classroom session. The general link to the student portal: app.evalytics.nl can be shown by the teacher in the classroom. When the student clicks this link or copies and pastes it into their browser, they will see an Evalytics login screen. On this screen, the student first chooses 'English' and then clicks 'Evaluate with code' and enters the evaluation code that the teacher previously received via email. The teacher passes this code to the student.



The student enters the code and clicks 'Start Evaluation'. The student then sees a UvA login screen and logs in to gain access to the evaluation.

'By invitation' phase: Students who could not fill out the evaluation during 'Live in the classroom' receive an email notification to fill out the evaluation. They receive this at the predetermined period (usually the week after the teaching period ends). Students have direct access to this link.

Good to know

A student cannot submit the evaluation multiple times. Checks are in place for this.
