As an intern, you will receive different types of tasks that you can take on. You are free to indicate where your interests lie and where you would like to develop yourself. For example, this could involve a fixed project where you work a set number of hours per week or month, or temporary actions where you contribute your part. Additionally, there will always be some simple ad hoc tasks that need to be done.

You will spend a portion of your time contributing to the social media team. This includes researching topics, creating various types of content, and working with tools like Canva and Social Pilot. This could involve writing texts as well as editing video material. Furthermore, the tasks you can perform will vary and depend on the field of study you are in. This could include tasks such as writing newsletters, press releases, fundraising, storytelling, and website management. You have the freedom to contribute in the way that suits you best.

During your internship, you can also contribute to the campaign team. In this role, you will work on different campaigns during specific periods. Currently, this includes the MOVE campaign, for instance, which might involve (co)organizing demonstrations, creative actions, and more. In addition to these established teams and tasks, there are plenty of projects on the agenda that we would like to take on and could greatly use your help for!

We aim for a commitment of at least 8 hours per week, but more is always welcome.
