- ▶ You are a second- or third-year bachelor student studying at a Dutch university (*fourth year bachelor students and higher with justifiable reasons for their study delay can also apply for the NAHSS, e.g. board year and/or internship)
- ▶ You are fluent in English in speech and writing.
- ▶ You have affinity with China and Southeast Asia.
- ▶ You are ambitious, social, active, open-minded, and entrepreneurial
- ▶ You are an excellent student and meet **at least one** of the following criteria:
 - Honours Student
 - Distinctive extracurricular activities
 - Above average grades ($\geq 7,5/10$)
